# What do you consider small?

The importance of cleanliness in a hydraulic system

In this month's edition of the Nexteligence Newsletter, we are going to look at the importance of changing your 3-micron in-tank return line filter. 70-80% of hydraulic system failures are directly related to contamination. In Heil refuse equipment, you should change your intank 3-micron return line filter every 6 months or 1000 hours with an OEM Heil filter element. But why you ask? Many filter manufacturers produce a 3-micron filter, but the Heil filter has the ability to filter down


to the 200 Beta ( $\beta$ ) ratio, which means a cleaner, healthier, longer-lasting life for your hydraulic system and components. What is Beta ratio and micron, and what does that mean to me?

### What is Beta ratio ( $\beta$ ) compared to micron ( $\mu$ )?




Beta ratio ( $\beta$ ) is the ratio of the number of particles of a minimum given size upstream of the filter to the number of particles of the same size and larger found downstream.

**Micron** is a unit of measure in the metric system that is equal to one-millionth of a meter and one-thousandth of a millimeter. In other words, microns measure things that are very small, even invisible to the naked eye. Let's take a look.



We tested the cleanliness of our hydraulic system with the Heil filter by measuring our 3-micron filters against non-OEM brands. Out of 200 particulates in the system, the Heil filter captured 199 particulates and the non-OEM only captured 100.
